

**CELEBRITY EMOTIONAL SUPPORT ANIMALS**

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INT. AIRPLANE (FRONT GALLEY) - DAY

A FLIGHT ATTENDANT (40s) welcomes BOARDING PASSENGERS with a smile as they pass by on the way to their seats.

FLIGHT ATTENDANT  
(to passenger)  
Hello.  
(to another)  
Good morning.

A FRAGILE WOMAN (20s) boards... with CNN reporter WOLF BLITZER (71) following behind her. As the attendant looks past the fragile woman--

FLIGHT ATTENDANT (CONT'D)  
(recognizing)  
Oh! Welcome aboard, Mr. Blitzer.  
Where are you seated?

Wolf silently looks over at the fragile woman.

FRAGILE WOMAN  
He's traveling with me. He's my  
celebrity emotional support animal.

The attendant CHUCKLES. Then--

FLIGHT ATTENDANT  
Oh, I get it. Support animal. *Wolf*  
Blitzer. Very funny. Seriously  
though, where--

FRAGILE WOMAN  
(holds out paperwork)  
I have his certification from my

(to Fidgety Vet)  
Sir, if you're asking if your  
support animal, *singer Sheryl Crow*,  
can sit on your lap, I believe  
that's a question for Sheryl Crow.

FIDGETING VET  
Thank you kindly.

The vet and Sheryl Crow head down the aisle. As they pass--

FLIGHT ATTENDANT  
(to Sheryl Crow, quietly)  
Love "Everyday Is A Winding Road."

ARTHRITIC GRANDMA (O.S.)  
Excuse me, dear.

The attendant looks back to find an ARTHRITIC GRANDMA (80s)--

ARTHRITIC GRANDMA (CONT'D)  
Does my emotional support--

--standing next to politician NEWT GINGRICH (76).

FLIGHT ATTENDANT  
Are you kidding me? Newt Gingrich?

ARTHRITIC GRANDMA

FLIGHT ATTENDANT

TONY HAWK

FLIGHT ATTENDANT  
Keep moving, Tony Hawk. Nothing to

(beat)

(beat)

Musician SEAL (56) walks onto the plane, which causes the flight attendant to burst out into CACKLING LAUGHTER. Then--

FLIGHT ATTENDANT (CONT'D)

SEAL

FLIGHT ATTENDANT  
Sure thing, Seal! So who do you belong to, huh?  
(looks past Seal)  
Got a PTSD victim with the shakes back there? Maybe a schizophrenic?

SEAL  
What?

The attendant stands in awkward silence: "Shit. Maybe it's just a coincidence that he's on this flight." Then--

FLIGHT ATTENDANT  
I am so sorry. It's just been a... crazy morning, to say the least.

SEAL  
We've all been there. Excuse me.

Seal starts to pass the attendant... then stops and realizes no one is behind him.

SEAL (CONT'D)  
(to someone off-screen)  
Come on, little buddy.

Actor MICHAEL J. FOX (58) boards the plane.

SEAL (CONT'D)  
(to Flight Attendant)

FLIGHT ATTENDANT  
(finishing)
